The County of Northumberland Pathways Educational Program provides conditional education grants to eligible residents who have been affected by a family member's Opioid Use Disorder. By investing in education and career advancement, the program helps individuals move forward while building a path toward long-term employment and self-sufficiency.



WHAT IS THE PATHWAYS PROGRAM?

The Pathways Educational Program provides conditional education grants to support eligible individuals pursuing higher education and other approved educational opportunities. The program helps remove financial barriers so eligible residents can pursue education and career advancement opportunities.

- 75% of your tuition up to \$7,500 per semester
- Awards are made on a rolling basis, subject to available funding.
- Pathways funding is applied to tuition after any other applicable grants, scholarships, or financial assistance.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Applicants must:

- Be a resident of Northumberland County
- Be affected by a family member's Opioid Use Disorder
- Be pursuing an approved educational or career advancement opportunity

Eligibility will be determined by the Northumberland County team and confirmed by the program administrator.



MORE THAN A GRANT

The Pathways Educational Program combines financial assistance with educational sessions designed to support participants throughout their educational journey.

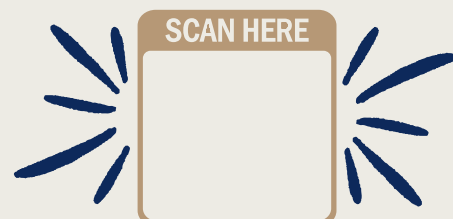

Applications will be reviewed to determine eligibility and funding availability. Meeting the eligibility requirements does not guarantee funding.
- 4 Award & Payment**
Approved grant funds will be issued directly to the educational institution after other applicable financial assistance has been applied.
